### **FORT WORTH, TX - Suspicious Person Investigation**

The Fort Worth Police Department and Eagle Mountain-Saginaw ISD Police Department continue to see information on social media, as well as news media of homeowner concerns related to a suspicious person in the community. As the allegations reportedly occurred in neighborhoods and not on school district property. The Fort Worth Police Department will be the lead agency in this investigation.

Fort Worth Police are aware of the suspect's identity and alleged actions. However, investigators have been unable to substantiate a criminal offense with the evidence provided thus far. We are asking that any residents who are able to provide evidence or information related to any crime to call the **Fort Worth Police Non-Emergency number at 817-392-4222**.

Regarding EMS ISD, the only criminal violation that occurred on January 22, 2024, at Boswell High School was entering the campus without following required visitor procedures. According to security video, the person in question never acted inappropriately nor did the person come in direct contact with any students. The person was inside the school for less than 10 minutes. EMS Police and campus administration immediately escorted the suspect off school property without incident.

Since there was no actual crime committed on school district property, EMS Police could not arrest the individual but did issue a criminal trespass warning effective for every campus in the district. EMS PD also shared information with Fort Worth PD to assist with any community reports they may have received.
