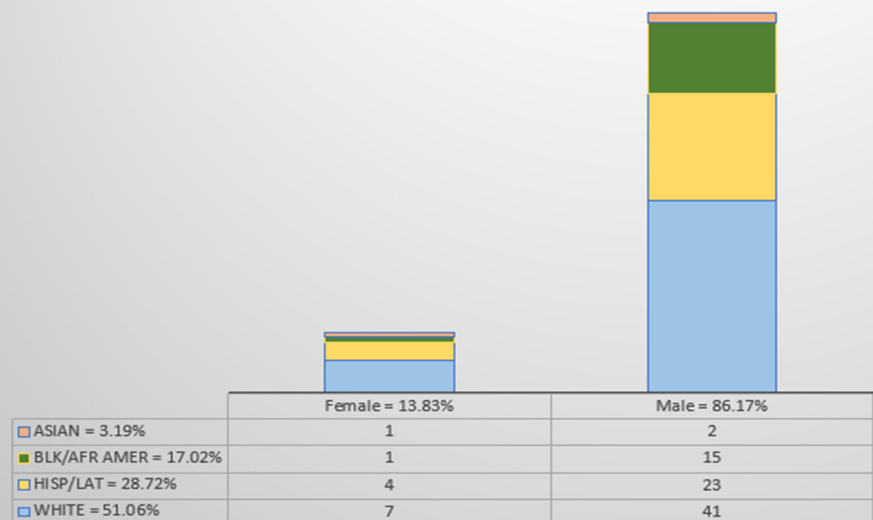
Police Cadet Gender & Race/Ethnicity



PD Rookies Gender & Race/Ethnicity

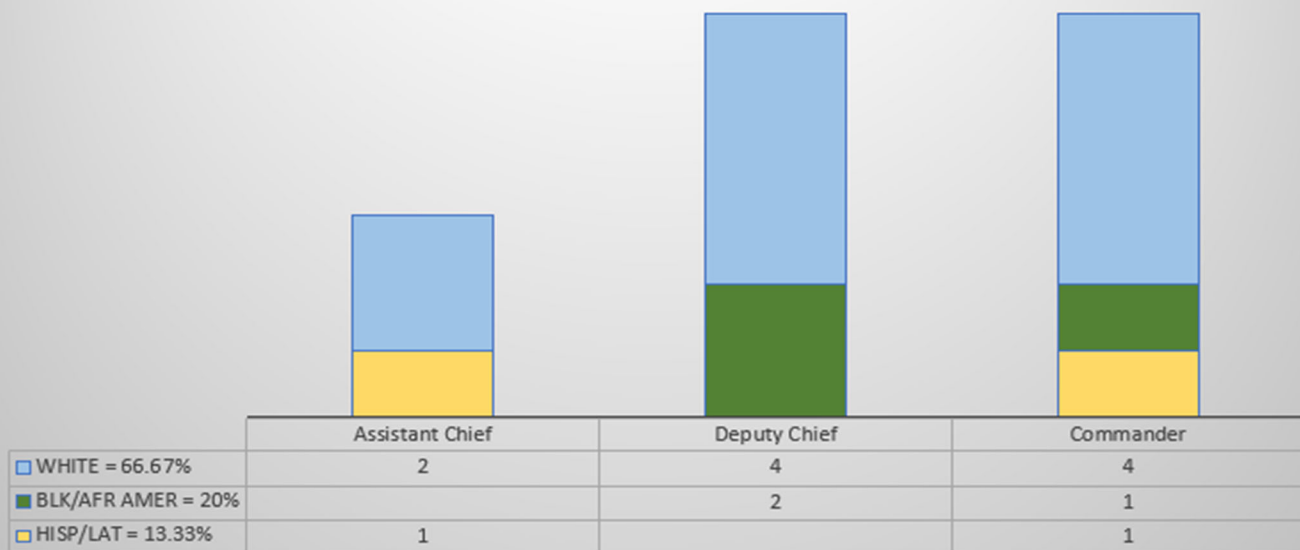

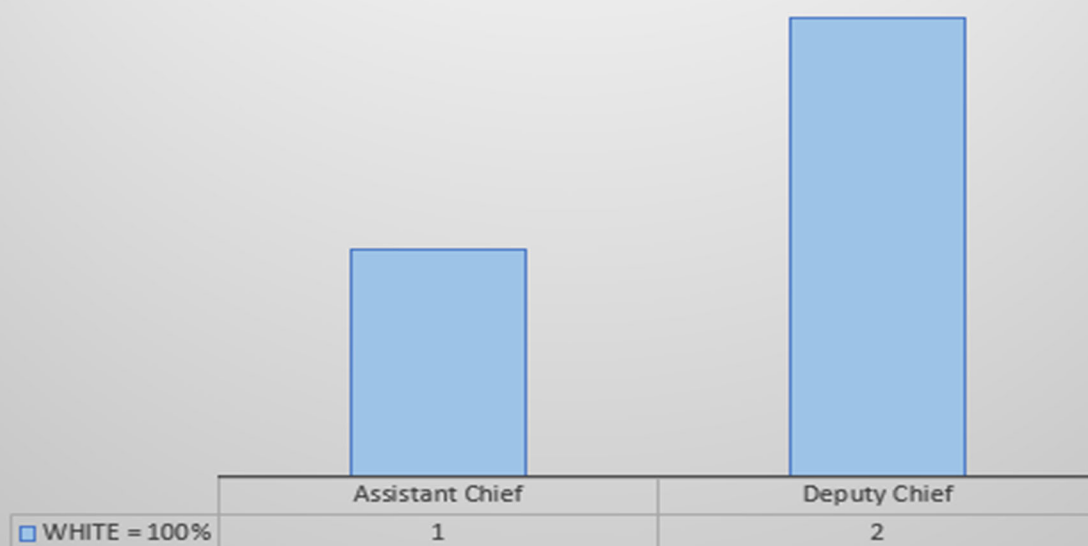
Patrol Bureau Appointed Ranks Race/Ethnicity



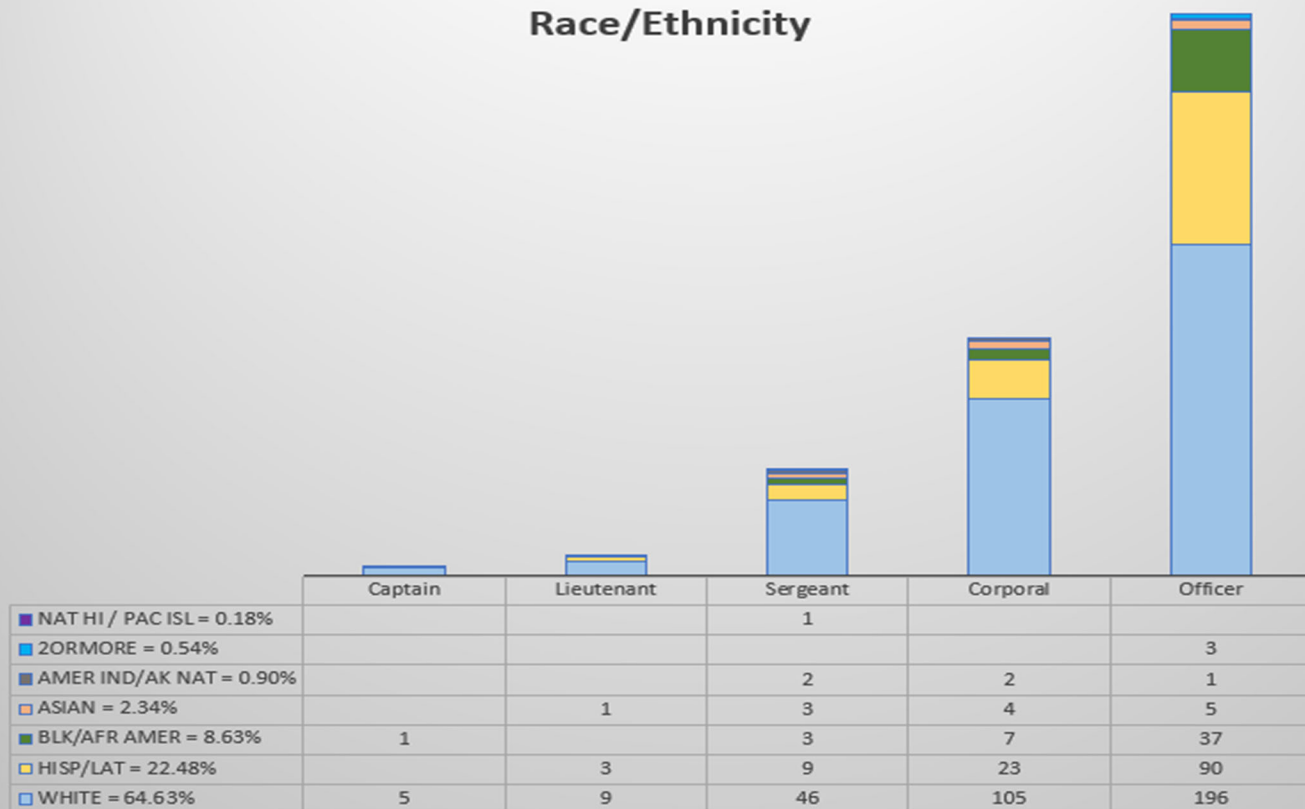
Patrol Bureau Tested Ranks Race/Ethnicity



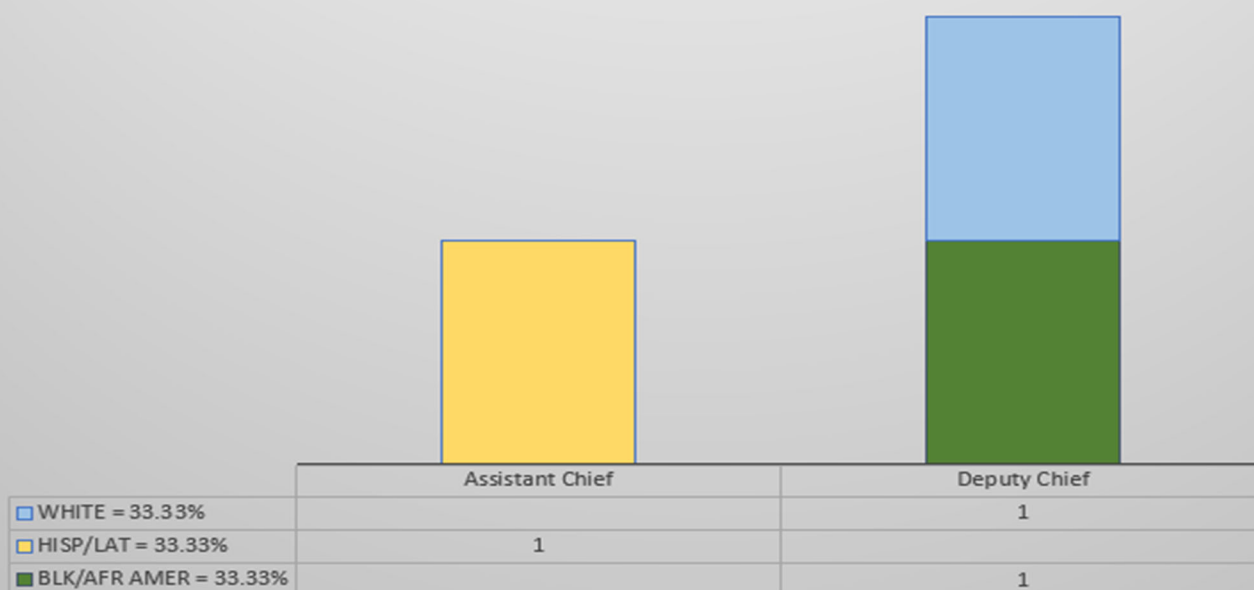
