- Force Analysis Section

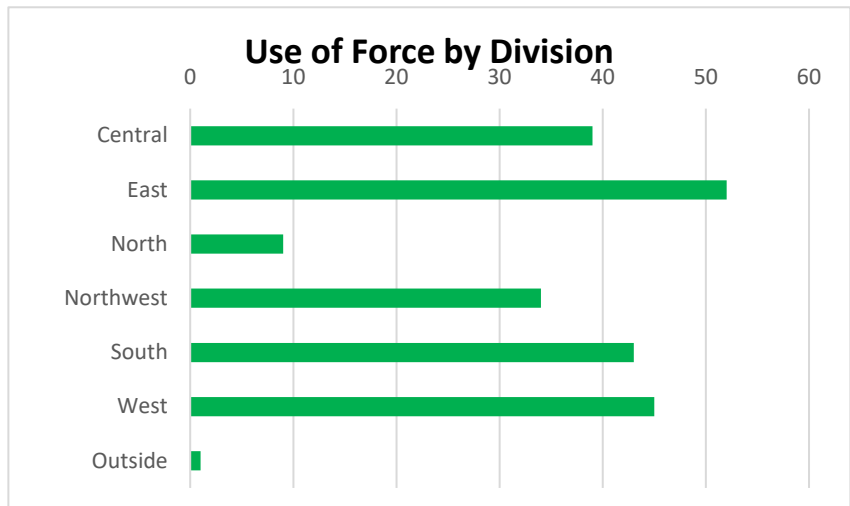
It is recommended that this data be used to guide and support both recruit and in-service training, with an emphasis on those force options that are most likely to be used or cause injury.

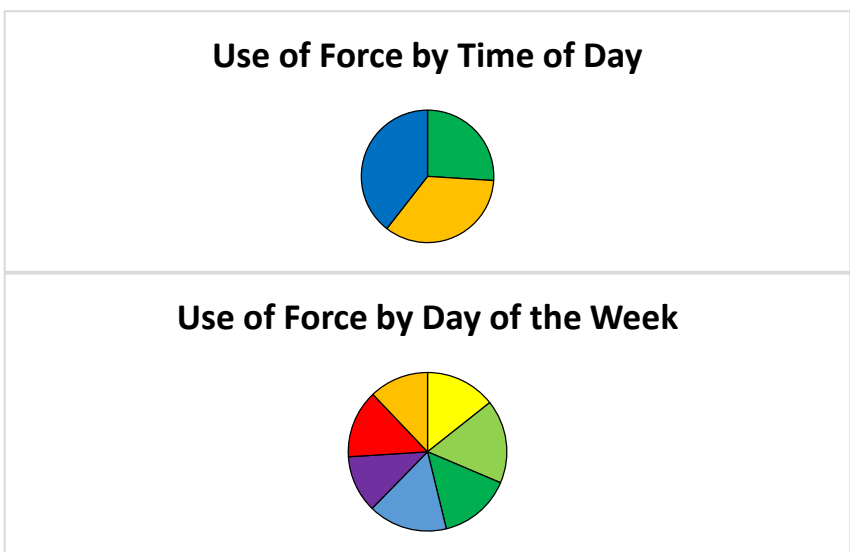

 This is **20.0%** of West Division's total uses of force.

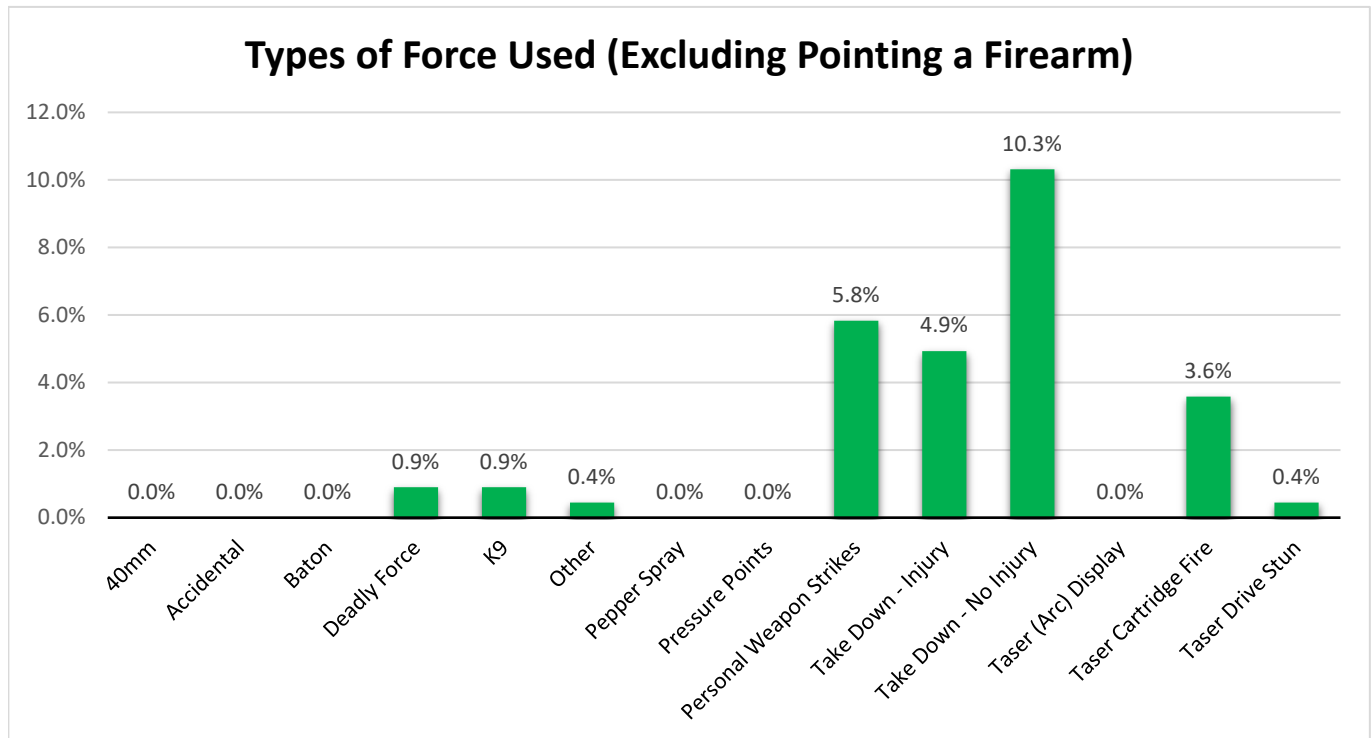

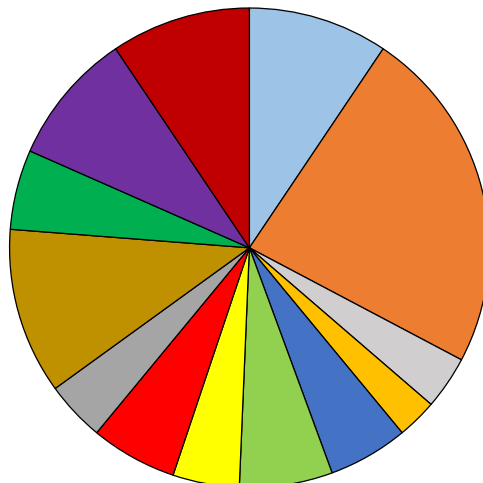

Rate of UOF by Call Type



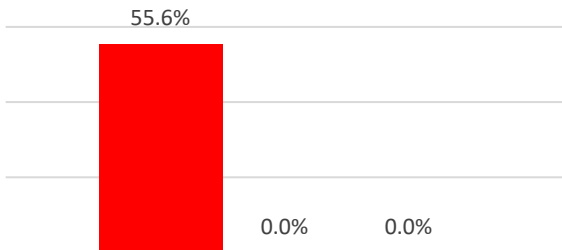

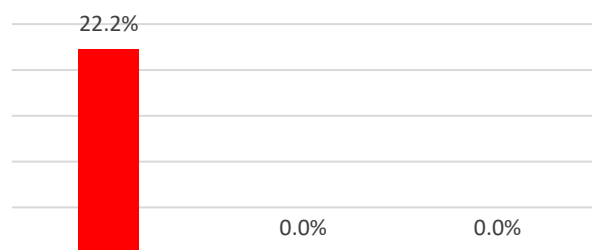
Taser Usage by Type of Deployment

Rate of Suspect Injuries by Deployment Type

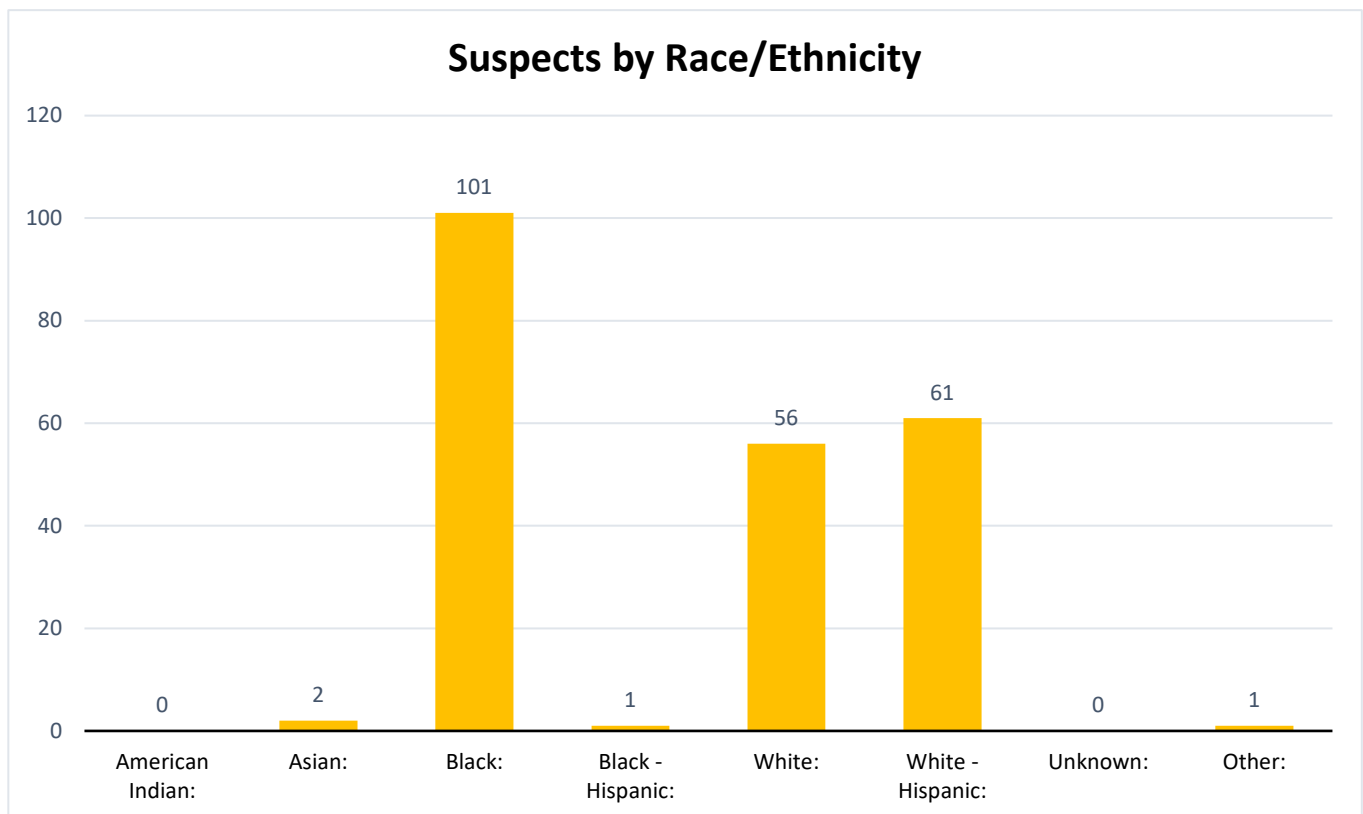

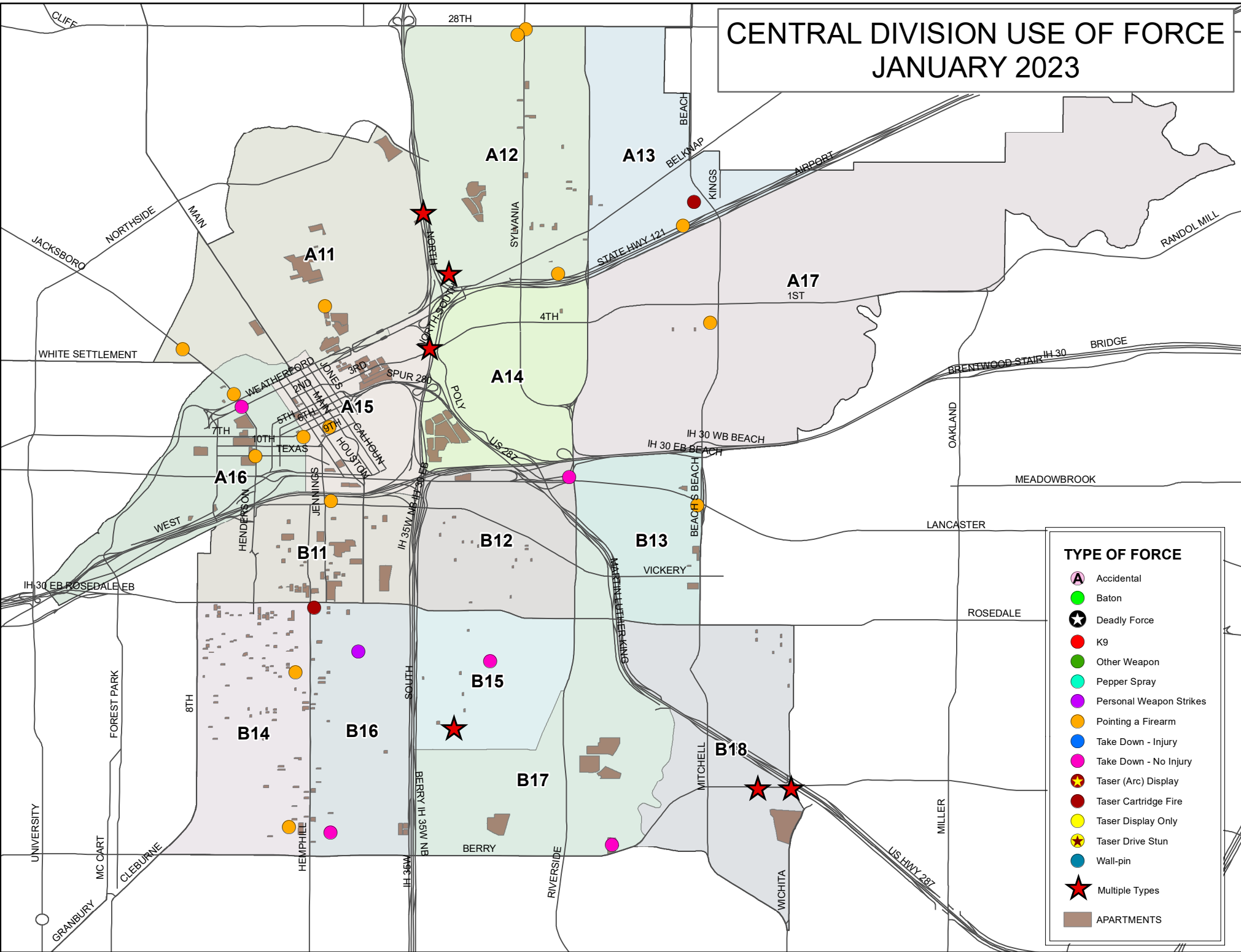
CITYWIDE USE OF FORCE JANUARY 2023



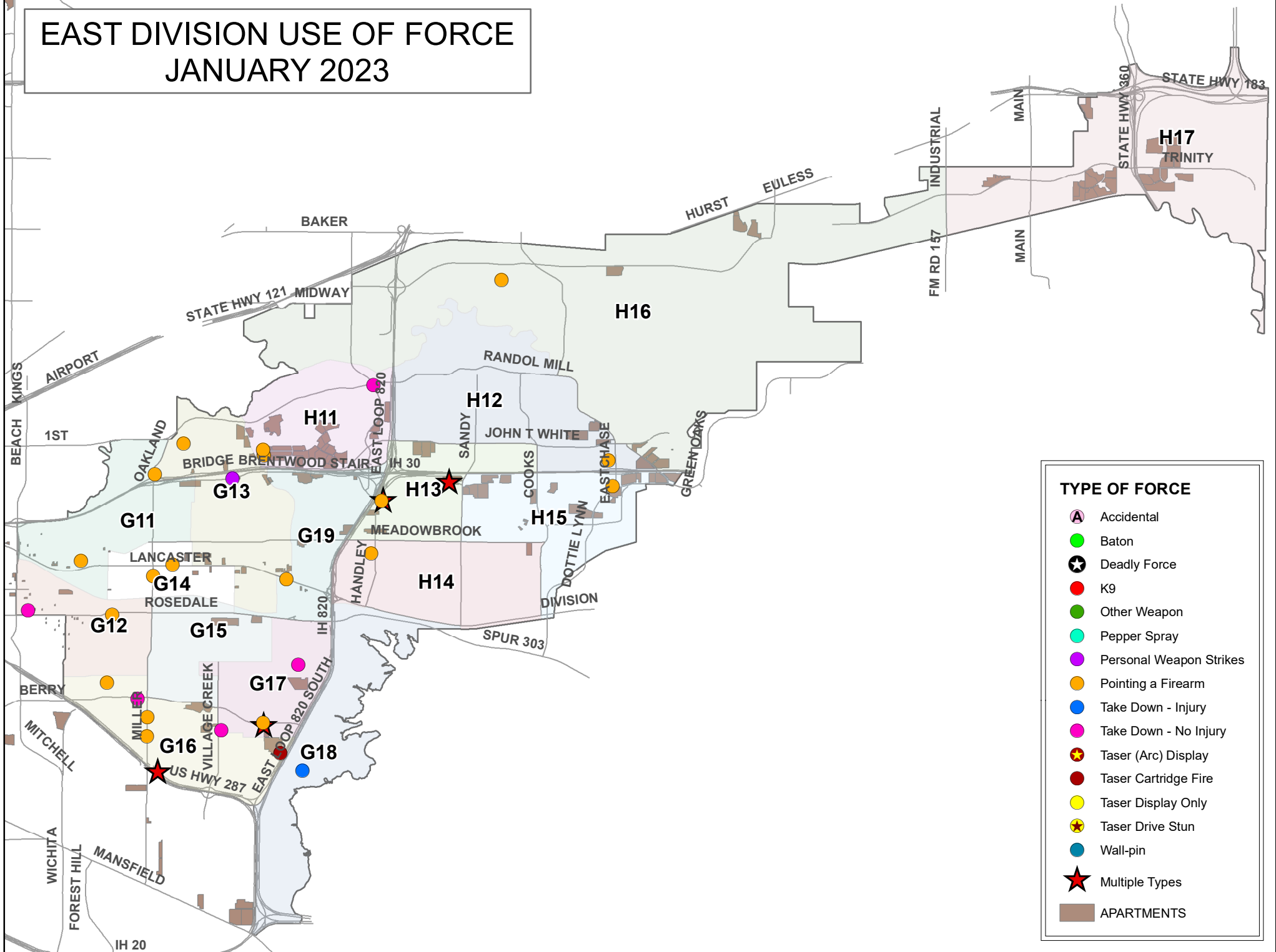

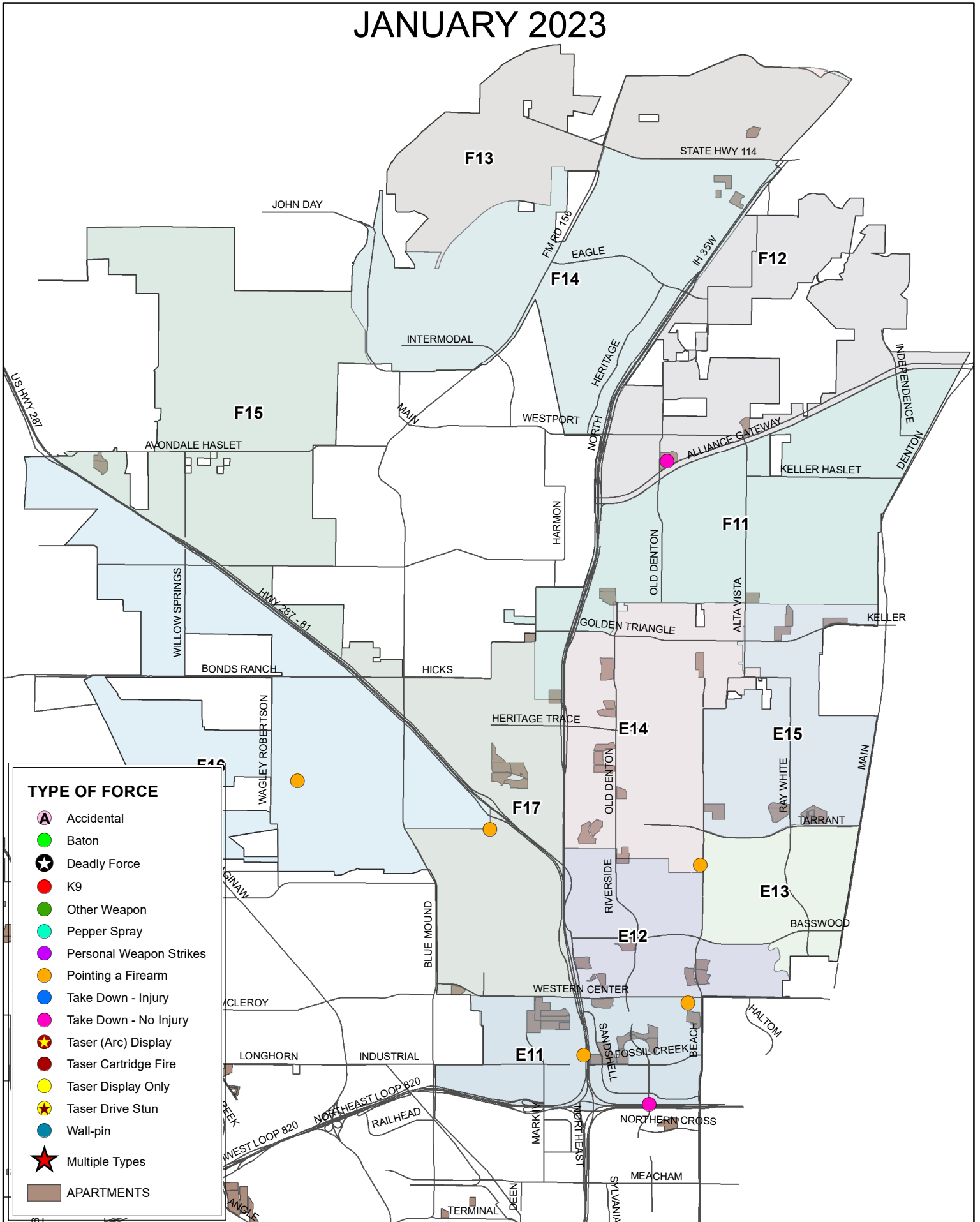


EAST DIVISION USE OF FORCE JANUARY 2023

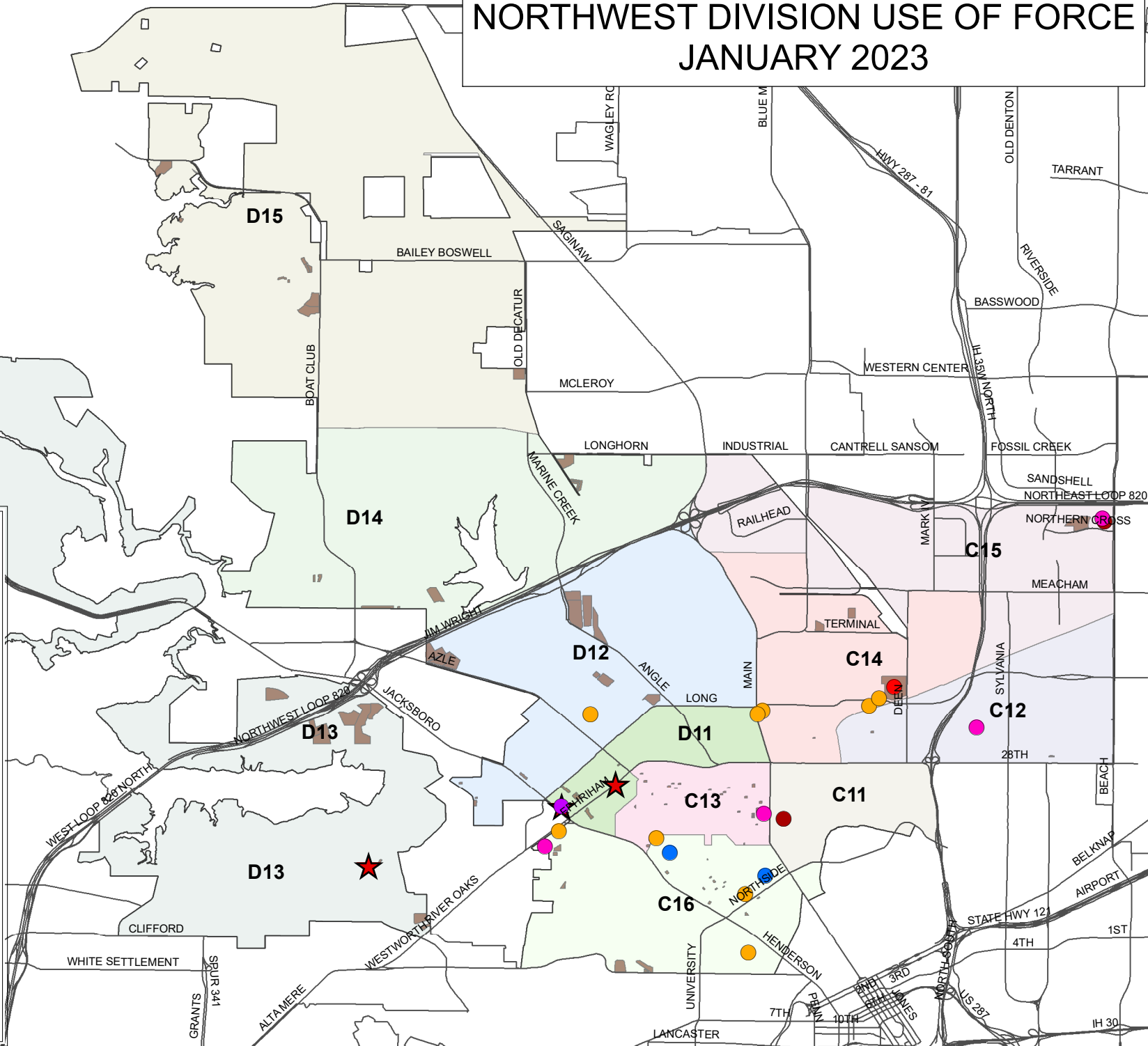

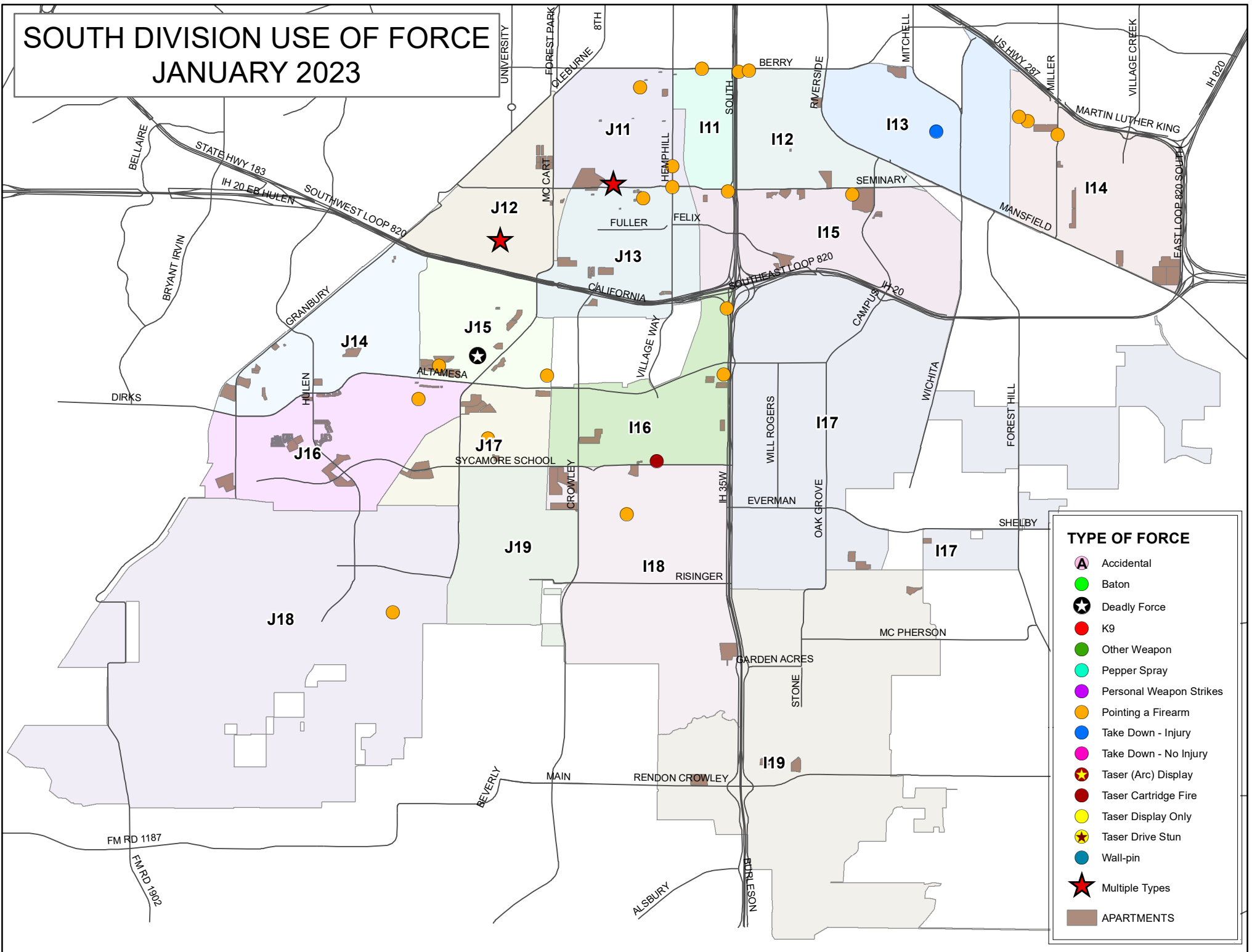

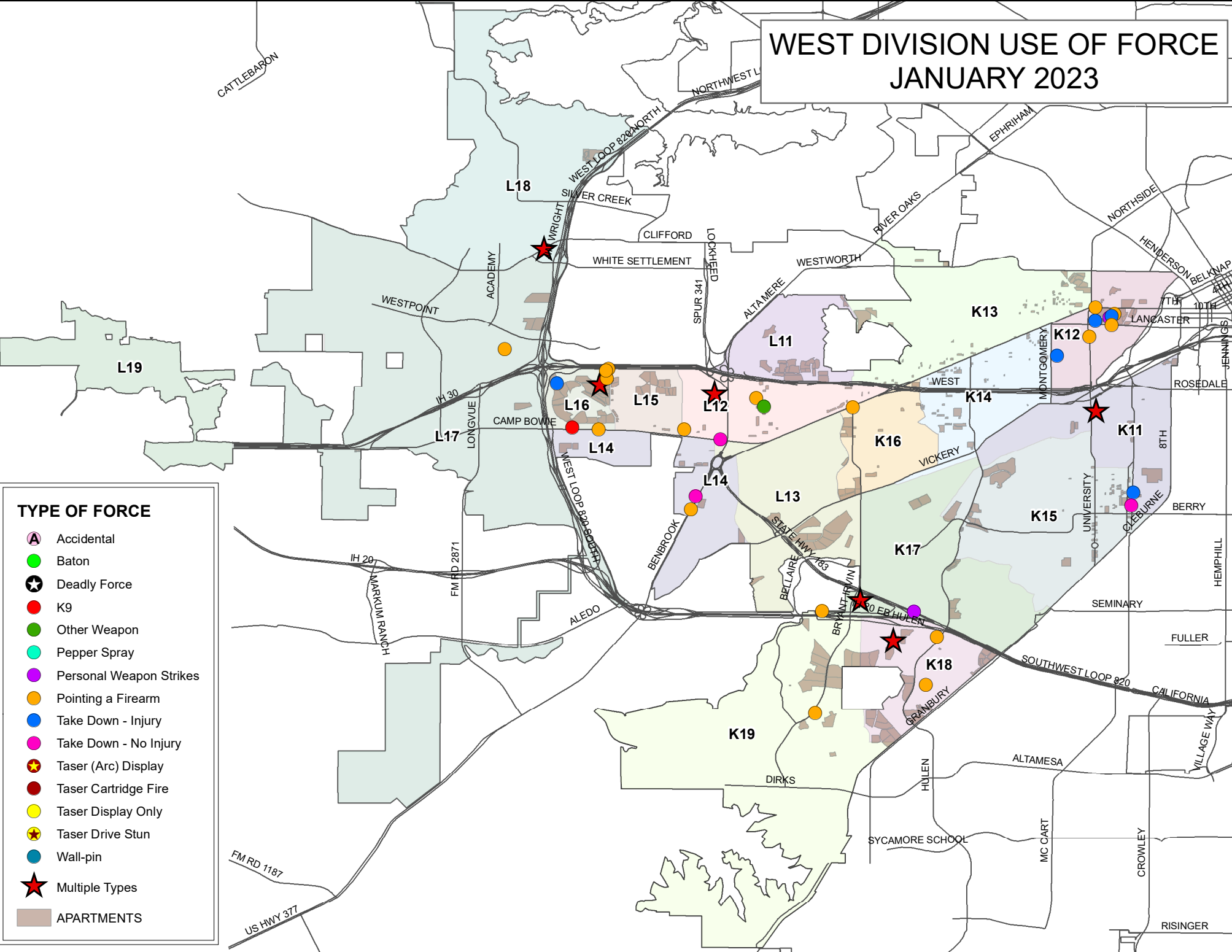
