- Force Analysis Section

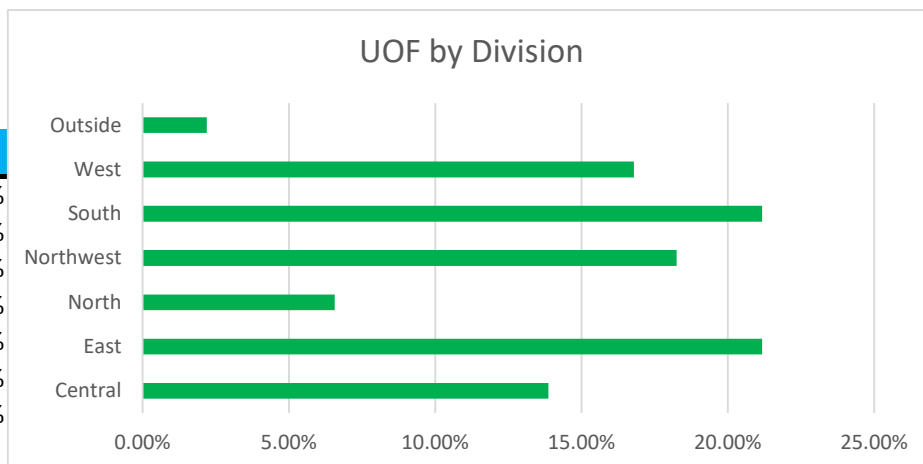

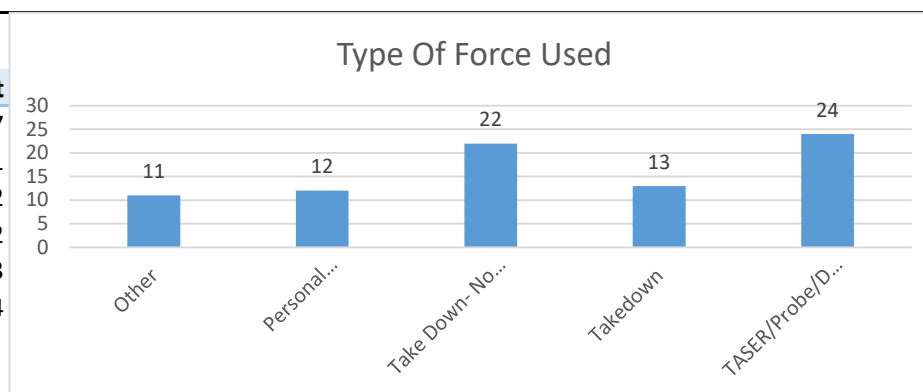


K12's beat encompasses the W. 7th Street corridor and had 1 total uses of force.

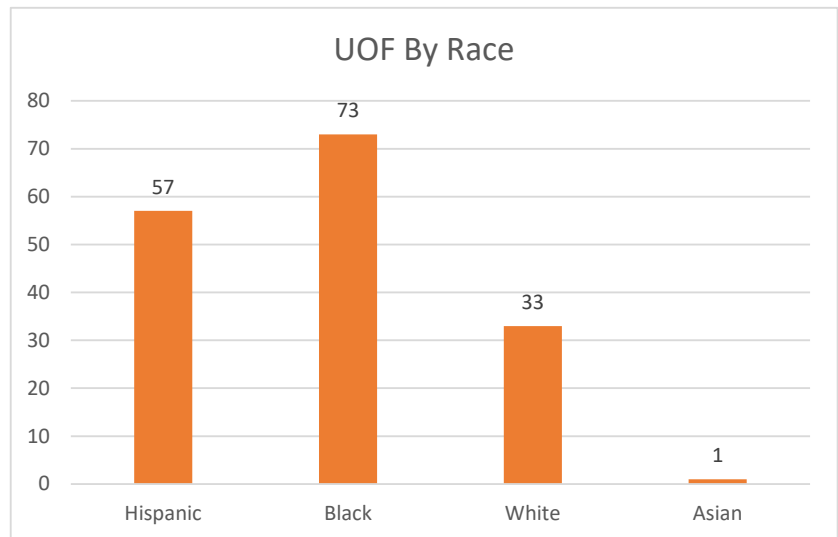

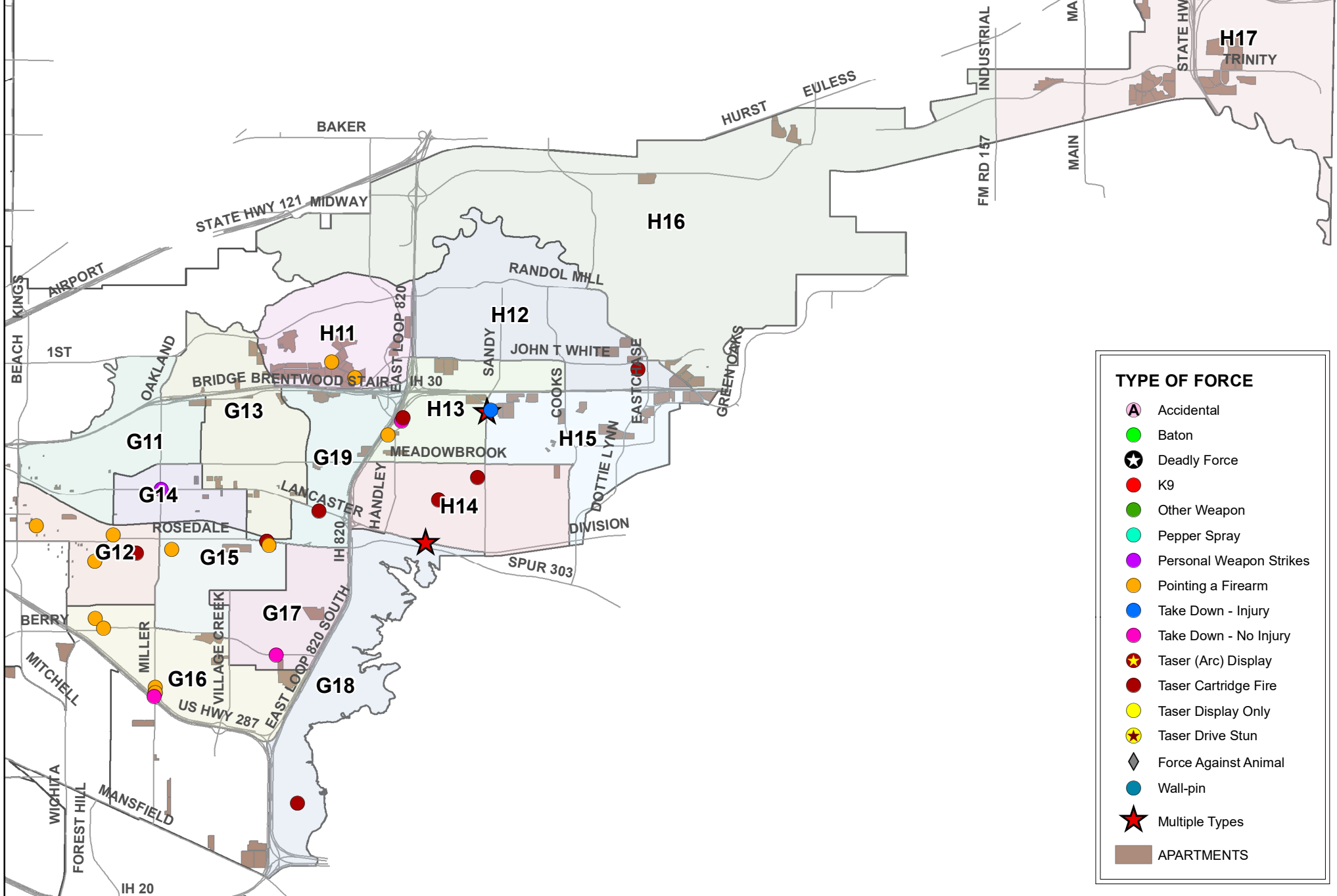


CENTRAL DIVISION USE OF FORCE APRIL 2025



EAST DIVISION USE OF FORCE

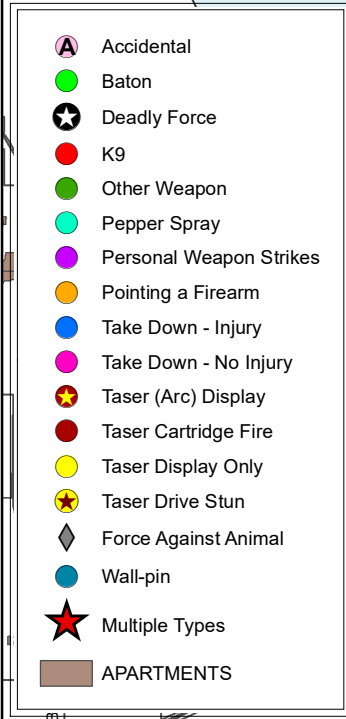

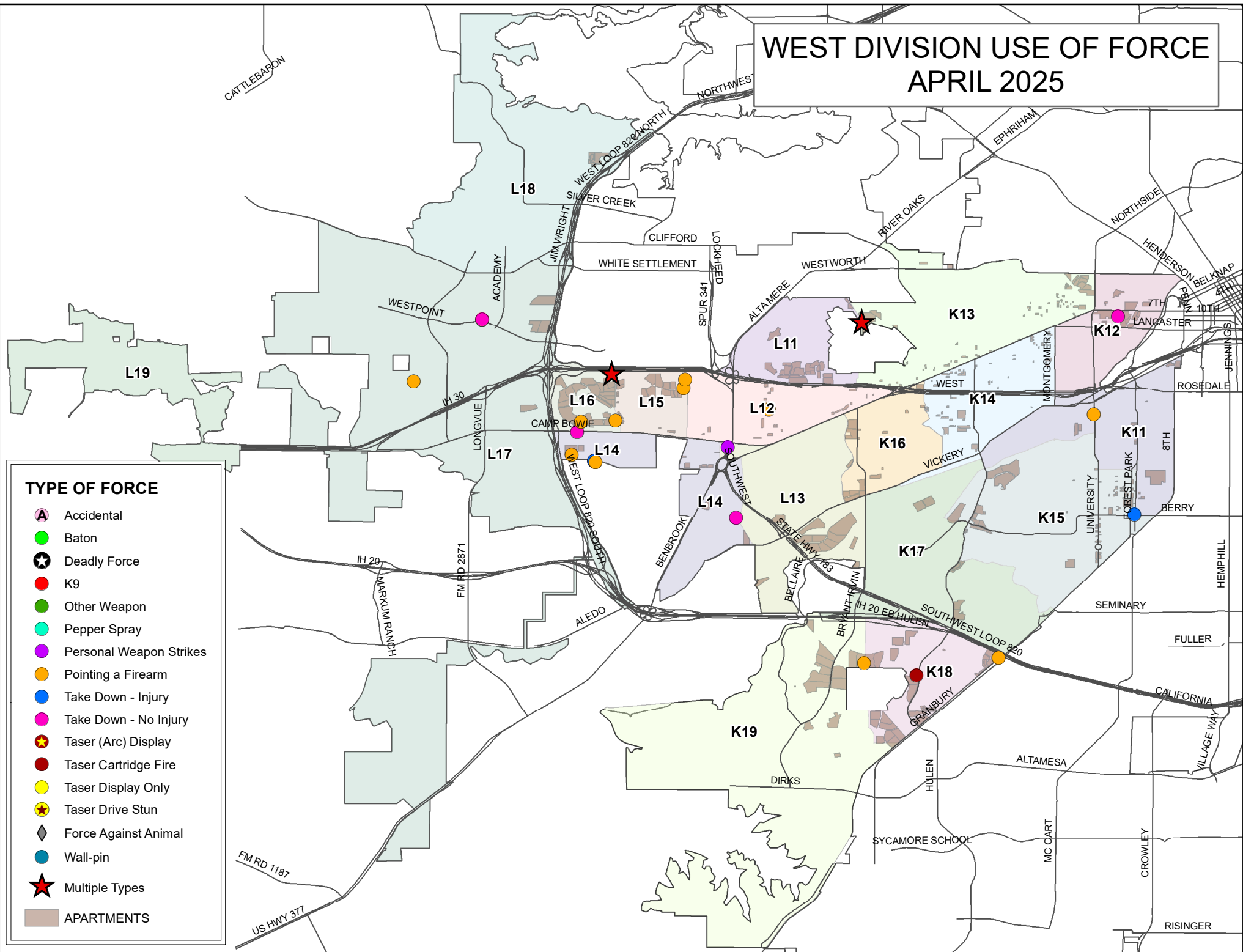
SOUTH DIVISION USE OF FORCE APRIL 2025
