- Force Analysis Section

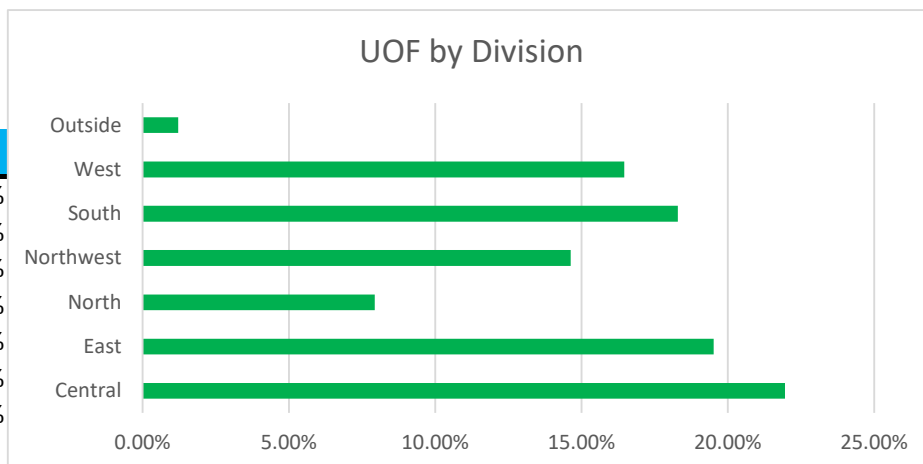

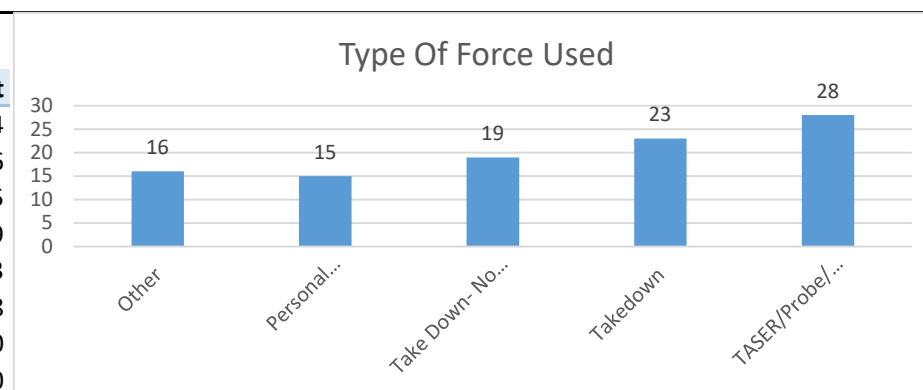


A14's beat encompasses the W. 7th Street corridor and had 4 total uses of force.

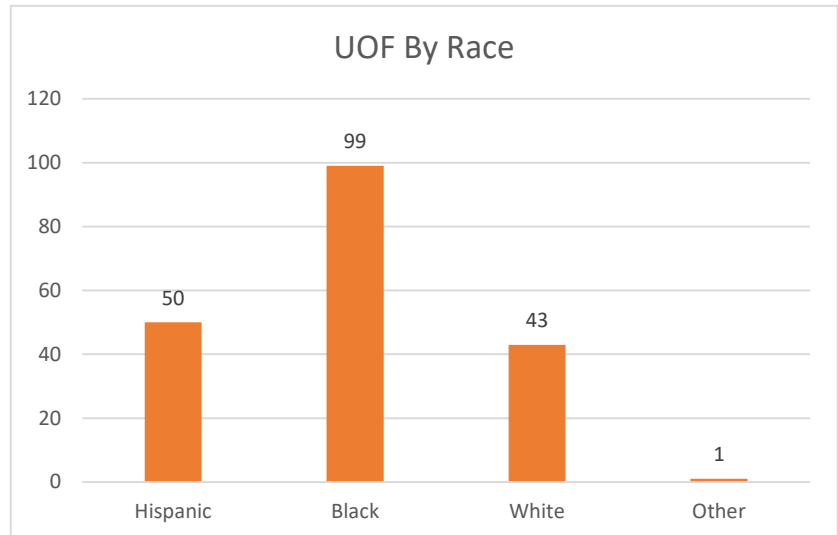

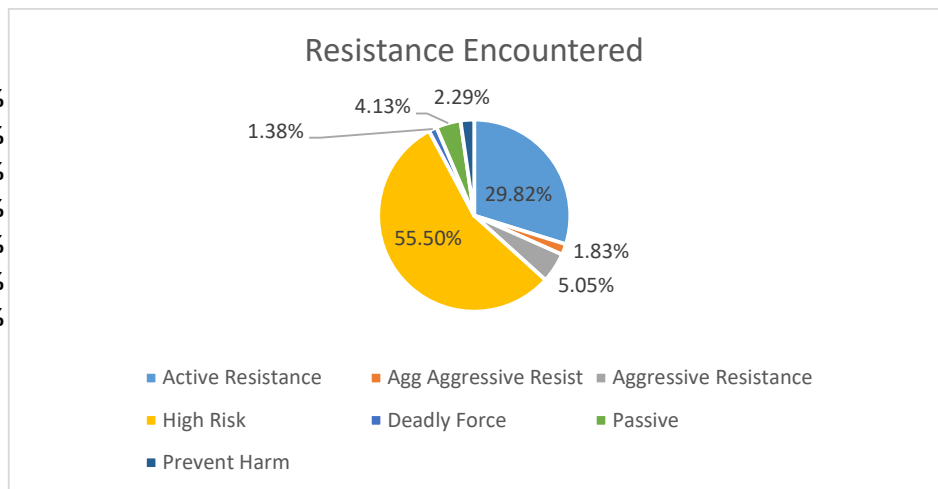

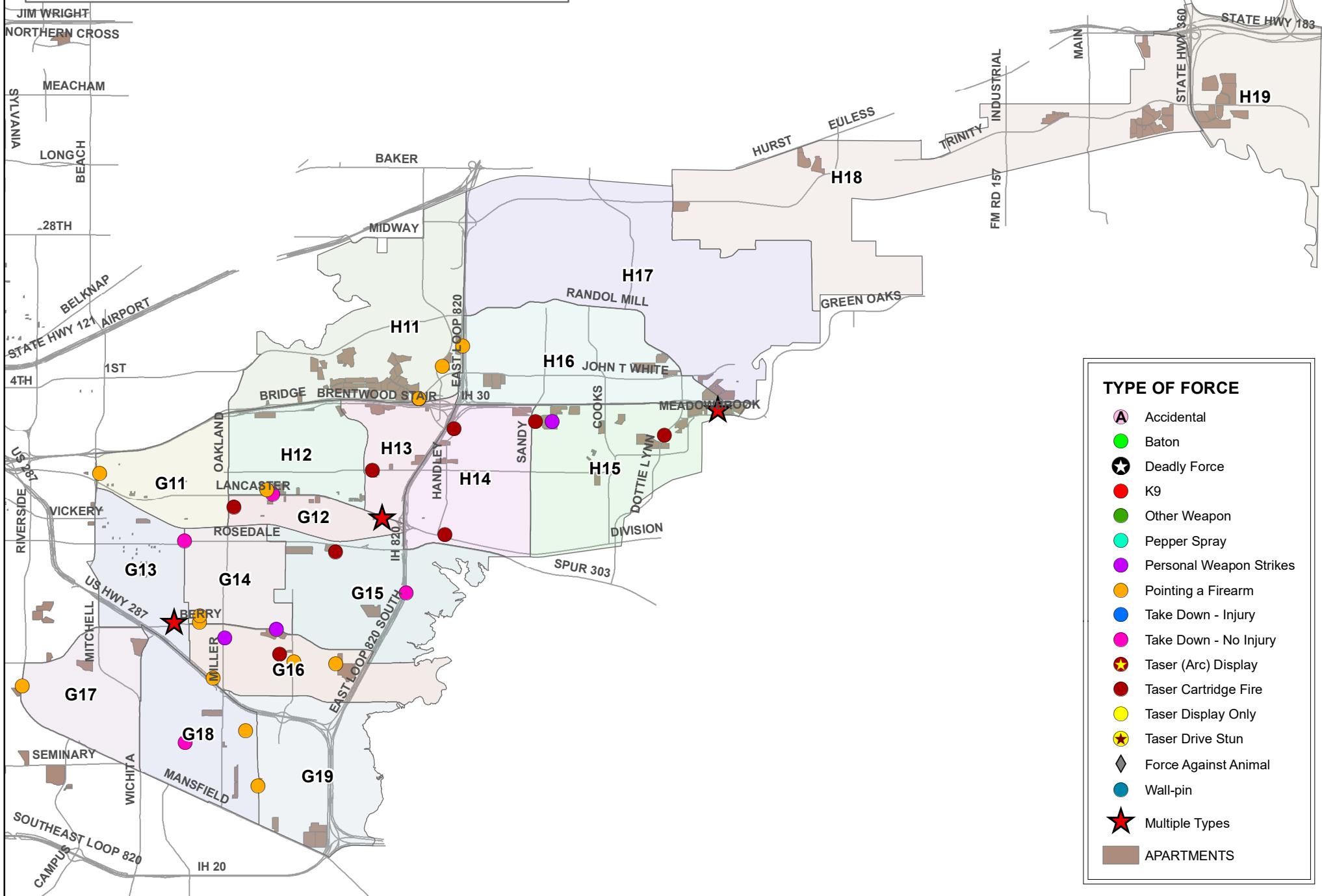

CENTRAL DIVISION USE OF FORCE AUGUST 2025

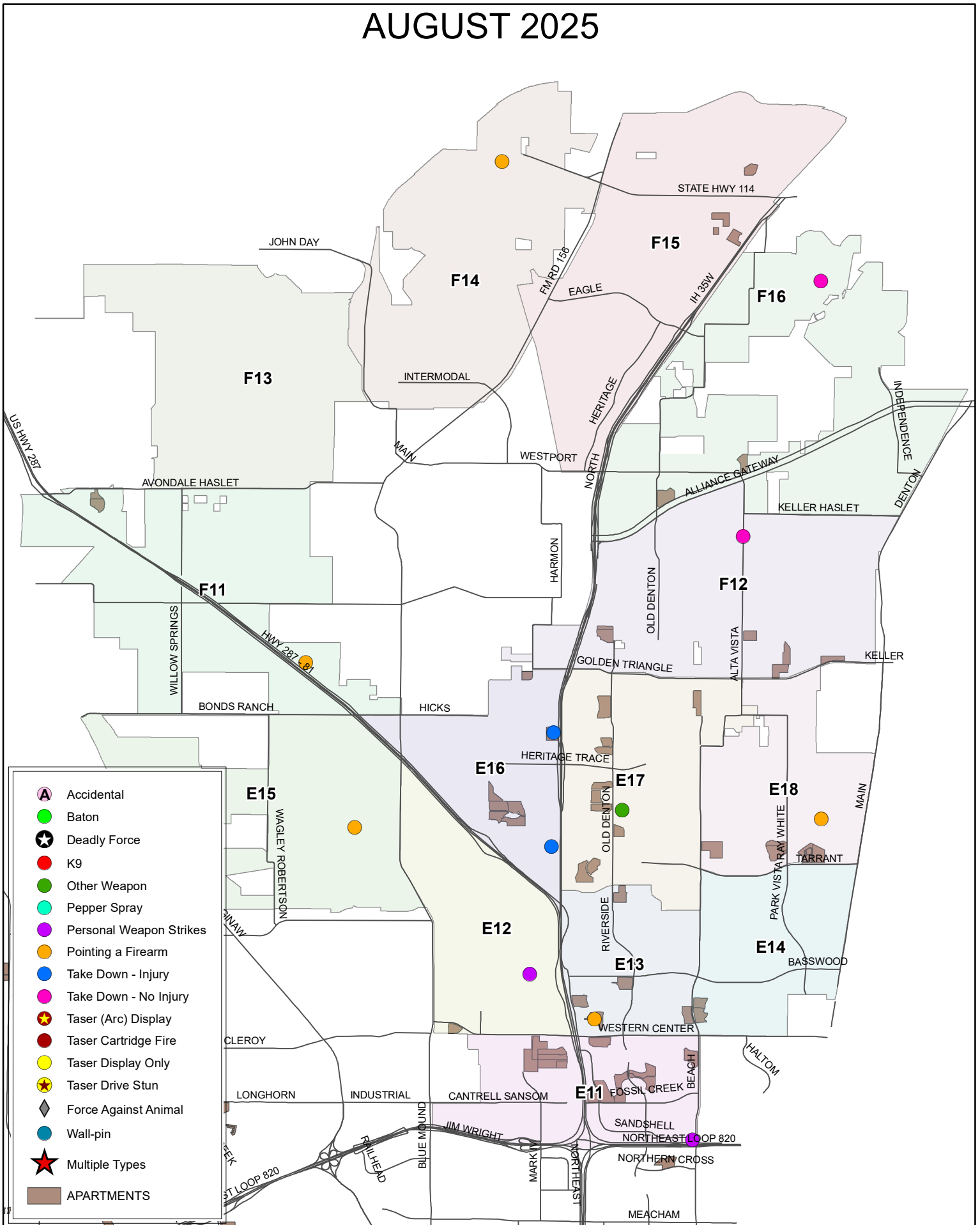


EAST DIVISION USE OF FORCE AUGUST 2025

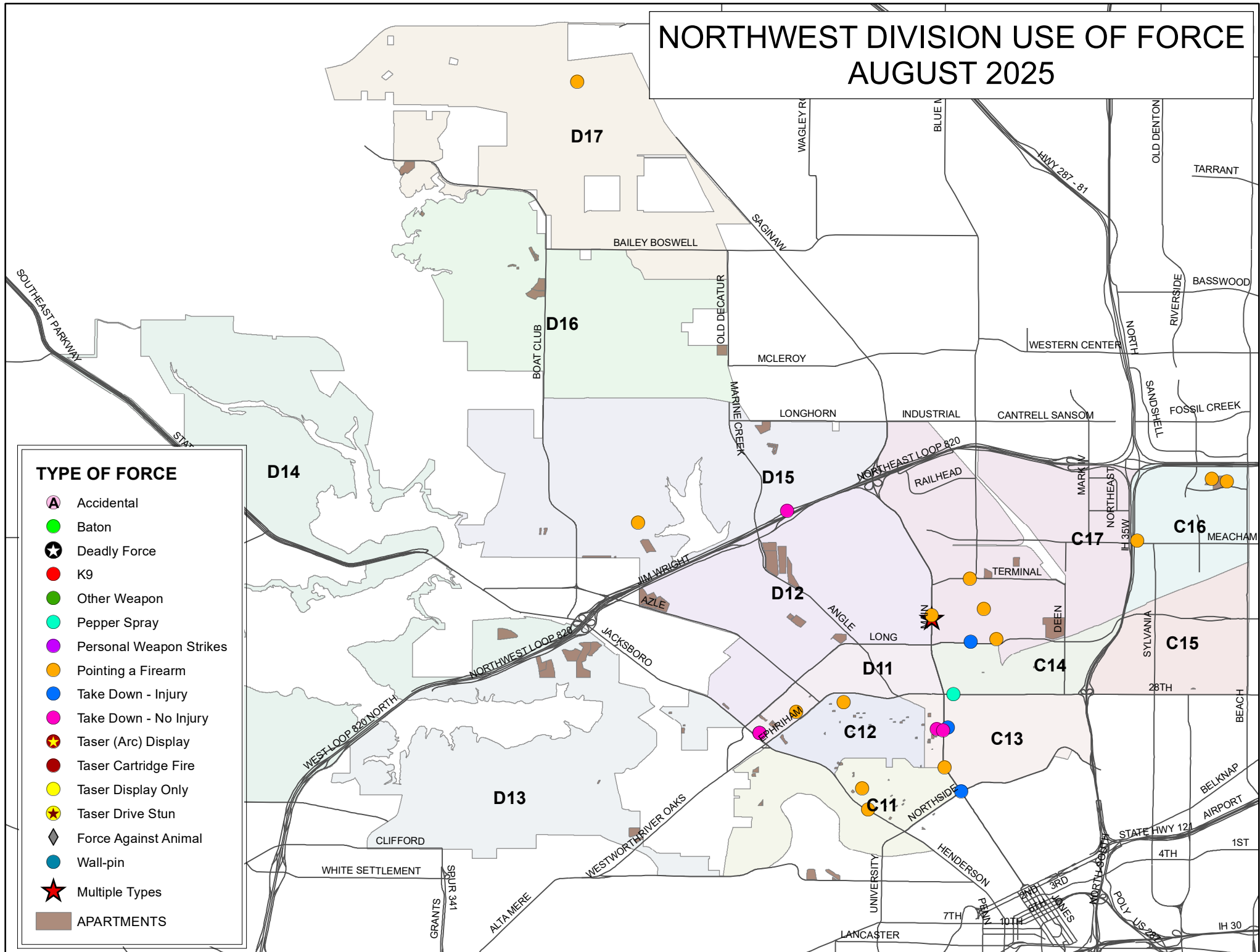


NORTH DIVISION USE OF FORCE

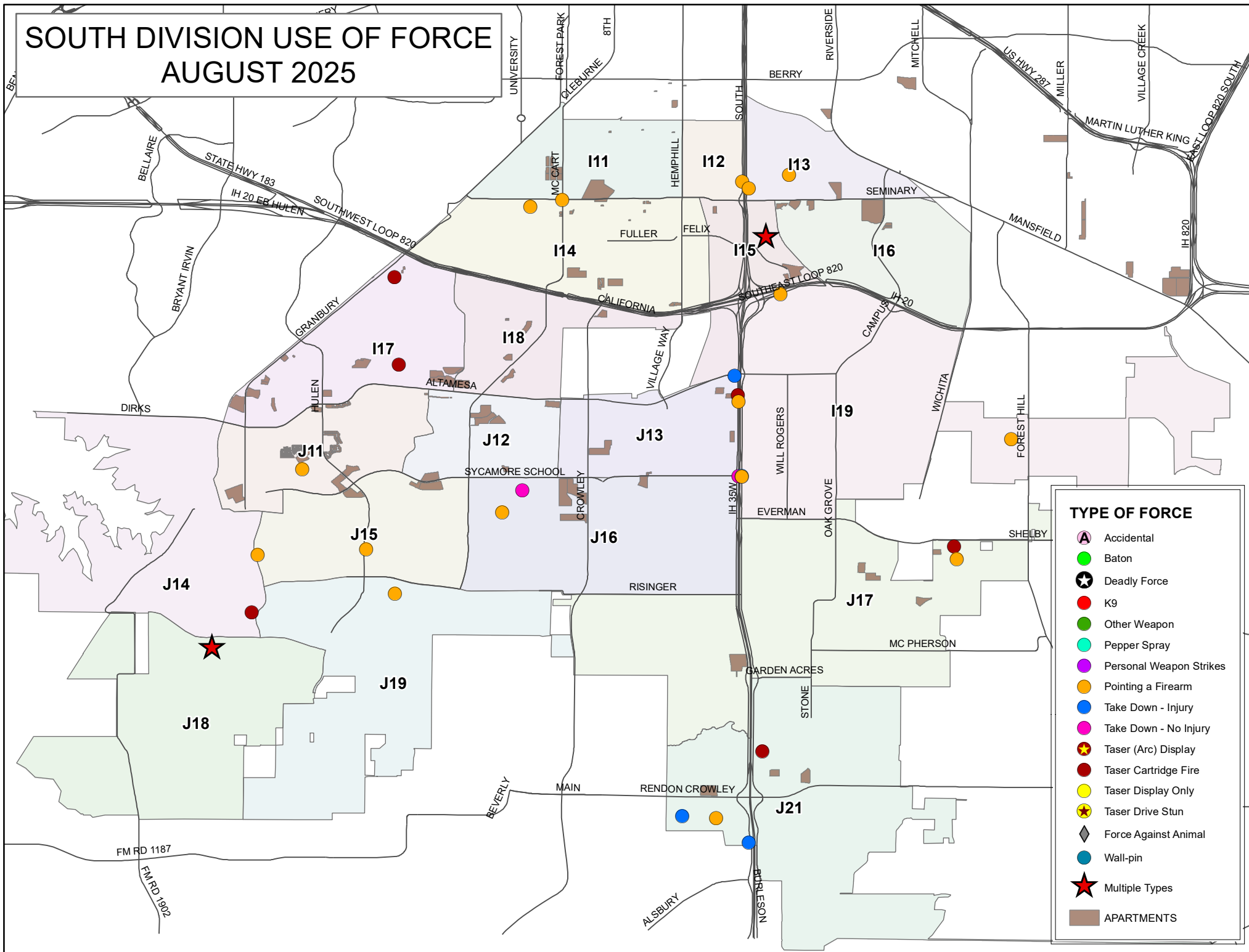

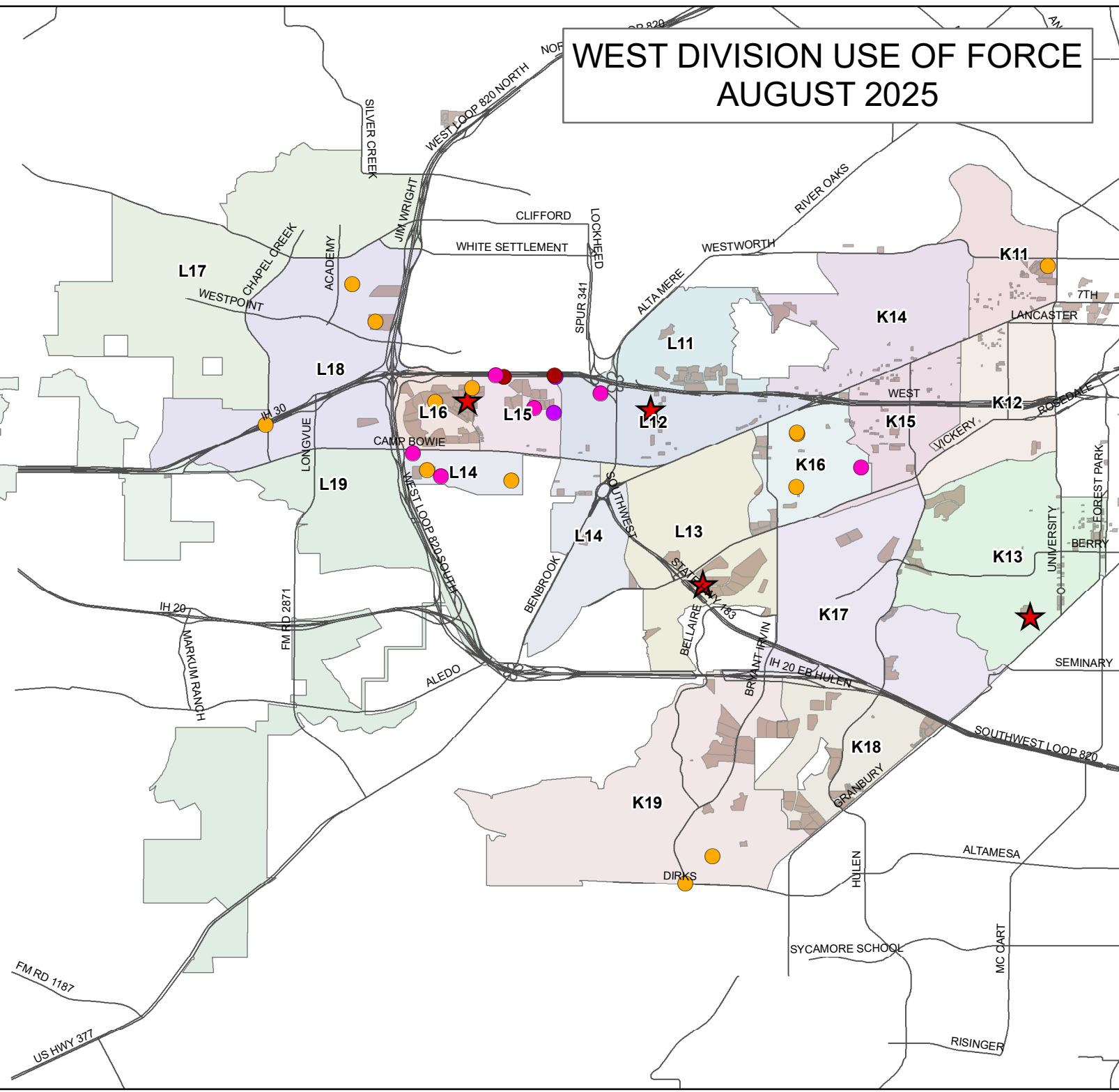
