- Force Analysis Section

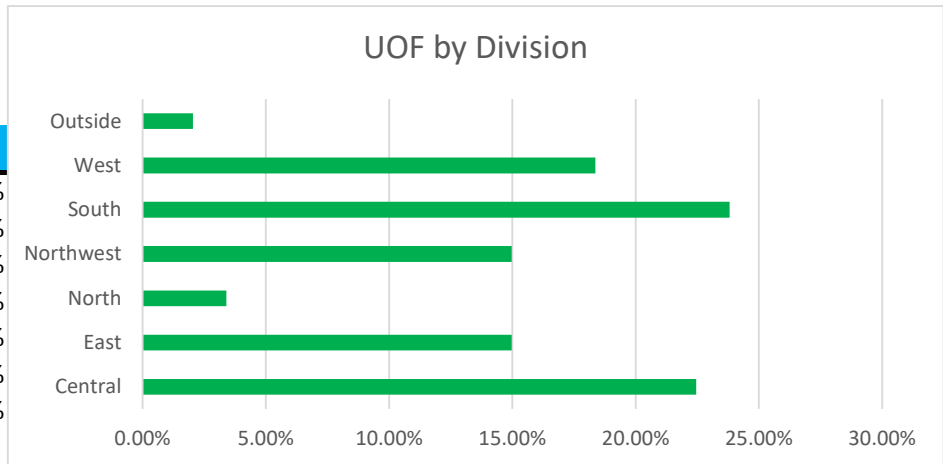

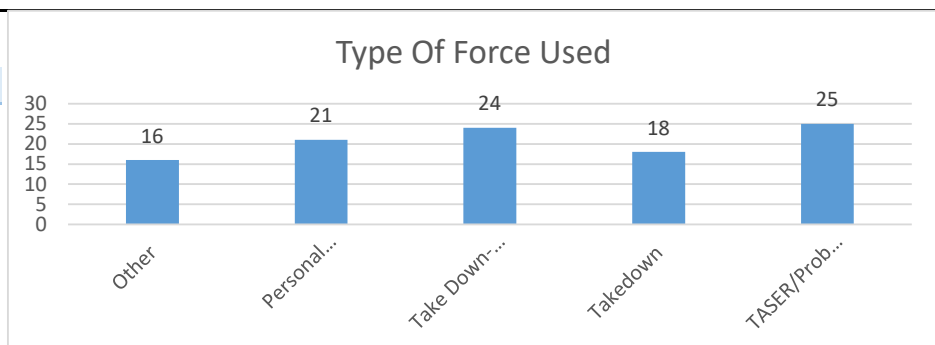


A14's beat encompasses the W. 7th Street corridor and had 6 total uses of force.

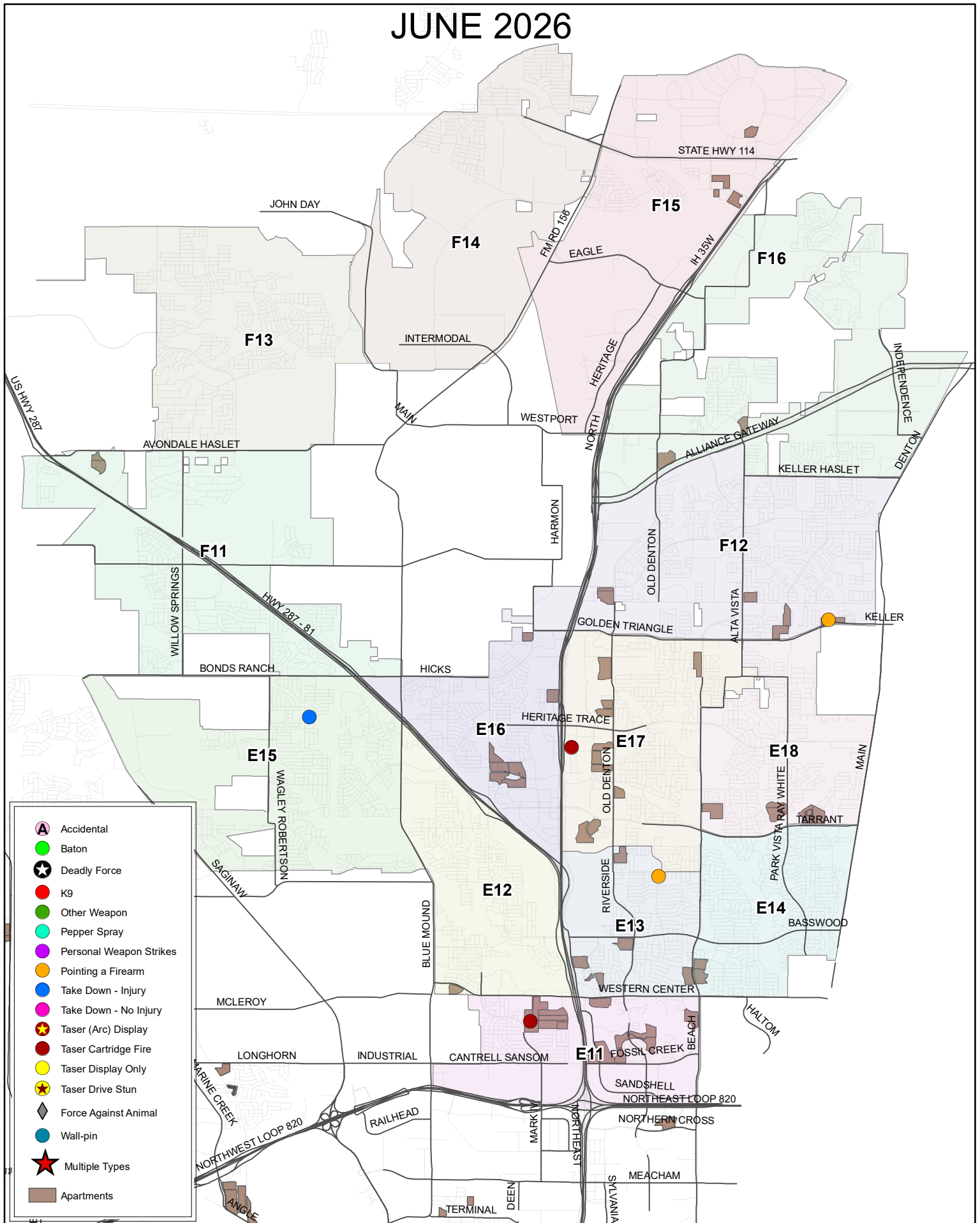

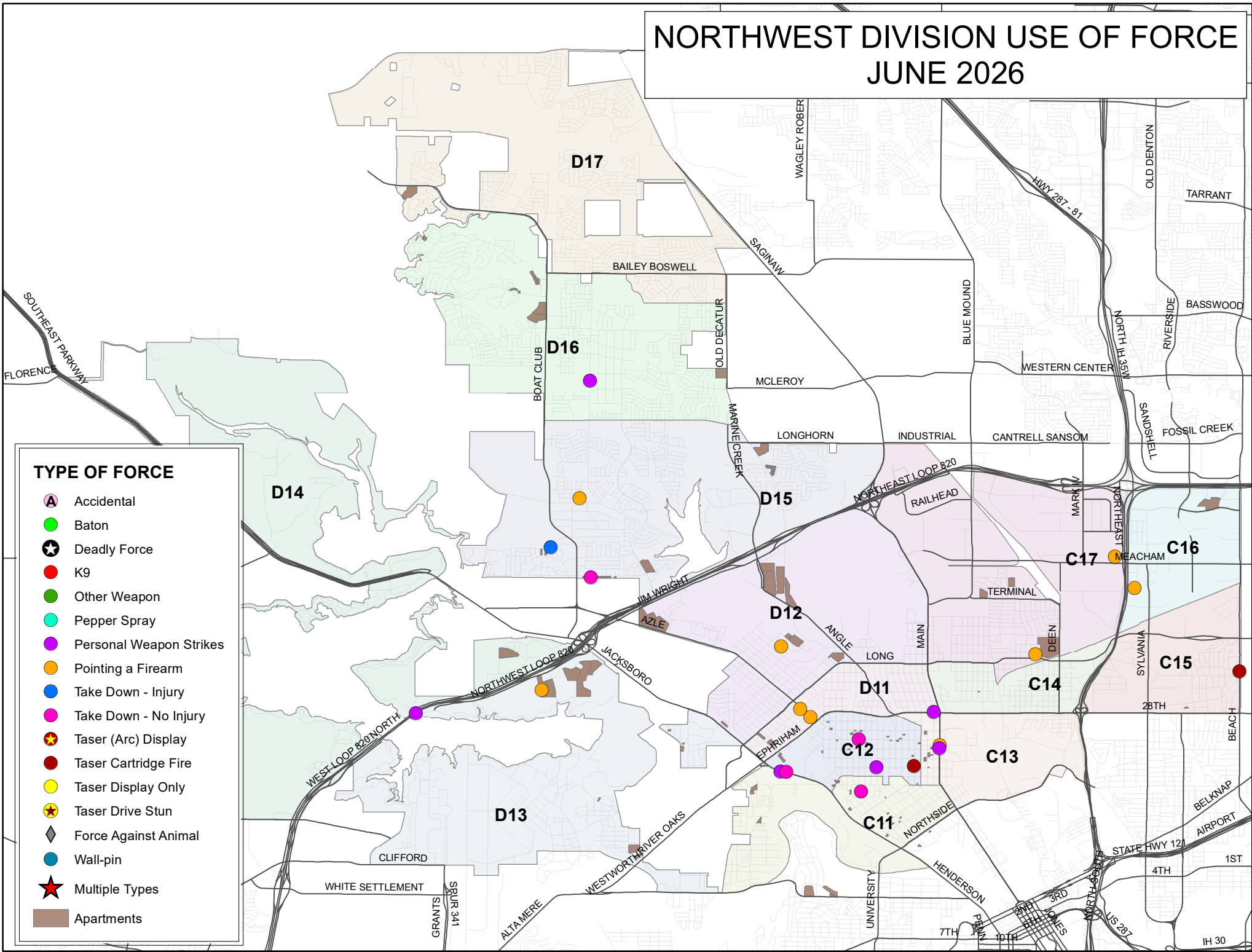
