What: Mayor Mattie Parker will present the American Warrior Association (AWA), Police Chief Noakes and Fire Chief Davis with a city of Fort Worth Proclamation to mark June 11 as Moral Injury Awareness Day. Just three months ago, the AWA, alongside the city of Fort Worth, Fort Worth Police Department and Fort Worth Fire Department launched **R3 - Respond, Restore, Resolve**; a comprehensive approach to addressing moral injury.

Moral injury is the damage done to one's conscience or moral compass when a person perpetrates, witnesses, or fails to prevent acts that transgress one's own moral beliefs, values, or ethical codes of conduct.
