Fort Worth Police Homicide Investigations

FORT WORTH, Texas – The Fort Worth Police Department Homicide Unit are investigating two homicides that occurred on January 1, 2025.

On January 1, 2025, East Division officers were dispatched to the 8800 block of Sabinas Trl. in reference to a shooting call. Upon arrival officers located the suspect exiting the residence where she was detained. Officers then located the victim inside of the residence with an apparent gunshot wound to his upper body/torso. Medical personnel were dispatched and performed medical intervention but the victim did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased on the scene. Detectives found that the victim and the suspect are in the process of getting a divorce but still reside in the same residence. The suspect, victim and a witness were involved in a verbal altercation when the suspect and the witness retreated to a bedroom and locked the door. The victim forced his way into the room and the suspect fired a handgun striking the victim in his upper body. Homicide detectives are investigating. No arrests have been made at this time.

On January 1, 2025, South Division officers were dispatched to the 5700 block of Crowley Rd. in reference to a shooting call. Upon arrival officers located the victim on the ground in a parking lot with an apparent gunshot wound to his upper body. Detectives found that the victim possibly confronted a car burglar in the parking lot and was shot during an altercation with the suspect. The suspect fled the scene immediately after the shooting. Homicide detectives are investigating. No arrests have been made at this time.
