## Officer-Involved Shooting

FORT WORTH, Texas – The Fort Worth Police Department is investigating an officer-involved shooting. On Thursday, January 9, 2025, at approximately 6:30 p.m., Northwest Division officers responded to a domestic disturbance call at a private residence in the 5600 block of Seafield Lane. The initial report indicated that the suspect was intoxicated and had discharged several rounds of gunfire inside the home.

Upon arriving at the scene, officers established a perimeter and attempted to make contact with the suspect using loud hailing. During this time, additional gunshots were heard coming from inside the residence.

The suspect exited the home and fired his weapon at officers. In response, multiple officers returned fire, striking the suspect.

Medical assistance was immediately rendered by officers from the Tactical Medical Unit and MedStar personnel. The suspect was transported to a local hospital, where he remains in critical condition.

No officers or civilians were injured during the incident.

The department's Major Case Unit has been notified and will lead a thorough investigation into the events surrounding this incident.

The department remains committed to ensuring public safety and transparency as the investigation continues. Further updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
